### SHOW RULES



**Fun show Rules are the same as the usual club show rules. No exceptions. Competitors do not need to wear traditional show clothing but should follow all other rules around footwear and hats and must wear long sleeves for all classes.**

1. The committee have the right to decide on matters not covered.
2. Competitors must wear hard hats complying with current British Safety standards and be fastened at all times whilst mounted unless competitors 18 years.
3. Correct attire to be worn when competing in all classes.
4. The committee will not tolerate any mistreatment of any horse/pony by owners or any person. Anyone persisting will be banned from the club.
5. Animals under the age of 4 years MUST NOT be ridden on the showground.
6. Disorderly conduct or abuse towards officials will result in expulsion from the showground.
7. In the event of an objection concerning age of rider where age limits apply, a birth certificate must be produced prior to competing at further shows.
8. No whip to exceed 30" in length (30 inches)
9. Riders must not canter or gallop in spectator areas. Warm up areas must be used.
10. No non-competitive entries are allowed.
11. Entry fees are refunded at the discretion of the committee.
12. The committee/landowner/organisers do not accept any responsibility for accidents to any person, animal or property on the showground.
13. Dogs to be kept on leads at all times. Owners to pick up mess and dispose of correctly.
14. THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL. Objections to age or height restrictions must be submitted in writing with a deposit of £20. Deposits refunded if the objection is upheld.
15. Long hair should be worn in a hairnet or secured in such a way as not to hang below the collar.
16. Horses/ponies known to kick or misbehave must wear a red tail ribbon and be kept away from other animals and spectators where practicable.
17. Riders 16 years and under must NOT wear spurs.
18. Season points are not transferable in cases of change of owner/handler/rider in any class.
19. Once the gate of the show ring is closed, no more entries for the class will be taken.
20. LITTER MUST BE TAKEN HOME.
21. In case of a fall of rider, the rider must leave the ring un-mounted. Competitors are not allowed to compete that day until permission from first aider.
22. Stallions/colts to be bitted and their rider/handler must be 16 years and over.
23. Horseboxes/trailers must not be mucked out on the showground.
24. All equines entering the show ground must have up to date flu vaccinations. Proof of such may be requested and failure to provide the horses passport for inspection will result in expulsion.
25. You are **NOT** allowed to smoke/vape on Saddlers Show ground. If you wish to smoke/vape, you may do outside the gate at the top or bottom of the field.
26. All trophies should be returned clean and engraved by the October show. Failure to do so will result in competitors being charged for new trophies.
27. Ear rings, body studs or jewellery MUST NOT be worn.
28. People under the age of 4 years are NOT allowed to compete.

**Jumping Ring Morning – Start 11am, all classes completed before judges break for lunch**

### **1. Lead Rein Clear Round**

*Riders to be 10 years or Under on 01.01.25. Ponies 12.2hh or under. Jump height set to 20cm.*

### **2. Ride and Run**

*Open to all Horses and Ponies. Riders of any age, not competing on lead rein. Jump height set to 40cm. Horse and riders completes jump course, followed by a runner on their own two legs! Best combined time with least faults wins!*

### **3. Pairs Jumping**

*Open to all Horses and Ponies. Riders of any age, not competing on lead rein. Jump height set to 40cm. Horse and riders completes jump course one after the other as a team. Best combined time with least combined faults wins! Both competitors will need to enter individually and pay the standard entry fee for this class.*

### **4. Clear Round**

*Open to all Horses and Ponies. Riders of any age, not competing on lead rein. Jump height set to 55cm.*

### **5. Puissance**

*Open to all Horses and Ponies. Riders of any age, not competing on lead rein. Horse and rider attempt to clear an increasingly taller wall.*

#### **6. Hobby Horse Show Jumping**

*Complete the show jumping course in the fastest time without knocking any poles down. Competitors of any age. Jump height set to 30cm.*

#### **7. Hobby Horse High Jump**

*Open to competitors of any age. Attempt to clear an increasingly taller jump with your Hobby Horse.*

#### **10. Best Combination (Horse Most Like Owner)**

*Open to all Horses and Ponies. Competitor of any age. Can compete in hand or mounted, including lead rein.*

*Open to all Horses and Ponies. Competitor of any age. Can compete in hand or mounted, including lead rein.*

#### **12. Best Mane and Tail**

*Open to all Horses and Ponies. Competitor of any age. Can compete in hand or mounted, including lead rein.*

*Open to all Horses and Ponies. Competitor of any age. Can compete in hand or mounted, including lead rein.*

*Open to all female dogs who are to remain on the lead at all times. Competitor of any age.*

**17. Most Handsome Boy**

*Open to all male dogs who are to remain on the lead at all times. Competitor of any age.*

**18. Waggliest Tail**

*Open to all dogs who are to remain on the lead at all times. Competitor of any age.*

**B. Open Pony. Competitor of any age, pony to be 14.2hh or under**

**C. Open Horse. Competitor of any age. Horse to be over 14.2hh**

##### **27. Fancy Dress**

*Open to all Horses and Ponies. Competitor of any age. Can compete in hand or mounted, including lead rein.*

*This year's theme is Disney Characters.*

##### **28. Hobby Horse Showing**

*Open to competitors of any age. Showing class judged on individual show, demonstrated differences of gait and overall style.*

##### **29. Hobby Horse Races**

*Race around the ring. Split into two categories*

**A. Competitors 10 years and under as of 01.01.2025**

**B. Competitors 11 years and over as of 01.01.2025**
